



GRAND AVENUE STRUCTURAL REPAIR & RESURFACING [FALL 2016]

SCOPE OF PROJECT:

Grand Avenue from 4th street to 29th street (4 lanes). This includes crack repairs, milling, resurfacing, striping and some change out of signal lights.

PHASE 1

[Estimated start date 8.15.16]

12th street to 29th street (Eastbound Lanes)

What should you expect: Southbound traffic off of side streets will be able to turn left or right. Northbound traffic will only be able to turn left. Will change drop-off and pick-up for Grand Ave. Elementary School.

Longer travel times can be expected.

PHASE II

[Estimated start date ???.16]

12th Street to 29th Street (Westbound Lanes)

What should you expect: Northbound traffic off of side streets will be able to turn left or right. Southbound traffic will only be able to turn left. Will change drop-off and pick-up for Grand Ave. Elementary School.

Longer travel times can be expected.

PHASE III

[Estimated start date ???16]

4th Street to 12th Street (Eastbound Lanes)

What should you expect: Southbound traffic off of side streets will be able to turn left or right. Northbound traffic will only be able to turn left. Eastbound traffic will not be able to turn??? Onto 4th St.

PHASE IV

[Estimated start date ???16]

4th Street to 12th Street (Westbound Lanes)

What should you expect: Northbound traffic off of side streets will be able to turn left or right. Southbound traffic will only be able to turn left. Westbound traffic will not be able to turn ??? onto 4th Street.

HOW WILL TRAFFIC BE DIRECTED?

Flagging and signals throughout the construction area.

CONSTRUCTION DEADLINE

This project has been determined to be between 90 days to 120 days. The project will begin on August 15th and should be completed late November-December 2016.

COMPLETION PENALTY

The contractor will start incurring fines at 90-days in the amount of \$500/day. Due to the increased traffic flow during the Festival of Light and the holidays the fine will increase after November 25th to \$5,000/day.
